Camp Check In

Camper check in is from 5-6pm on opening day!

- Check in will take place at the Silver Sage Lodge once you arrive, which is about a half-mile in on the main road as you enter the property and on the right hand side!
- Hooray! We are so excited to welcome our campers to camp!
- Parents and campers will arrive and meet our incredible staff at the check in tables where they will check in and fill out any remaining paperwork, turn in medications, and get their room assignments!

Camp Check Out

Camper check out is from 11am-12pm on closing day!

- Check out will be at the Silver Sage Lodge building as well!
- Your designated person for pick up will need to show ID in order to pick up your camper! (you get to designate that person for pickup in your required camper forms)
- If your camper is taking the shuttle down to the airport, the shuttle will leave at 12pm!

Transportation

Driving to camp?

Opening Day: Check in time is from 5:00-6:00pm at Silver Sage Lodge Closing Day: Check out is at 11:00am-12pm at Silver Sage Lodge

IMPORTANT: Please do not arrive at CAMP TELAPHIBA before 5:00pm on Opening Day, or 11am on closing

Flying to camp?

Please schedule flights to arrive and depart from Denver International Airport (DIA). Campers are required to fly into DIA between 1pm and 3pm on Opening Day, and fly out between 4pm and 7pm on Closing Day if they are planning to use the **camp shuttle. (The shuttle service we use to and from the airport is Epic Mountain Shuttles)

Unaccompanied Minors:

If your child is flying as an unaccompanied minor and will be held at the gate until we arrive, please let us know ahead of time so that we can arrange for a pass to go to the gate to pick them up. You must pay for the unaccompanied minor status in order for us to pick them up at their gate. Unaccompanied minors are required to fly into DIA between 1pm and 3pm on Opening Day, and fly out between 4pm and 7pm on Closing Day in order to use the **camp shuttle. If your camper arrives before this time frame, you will need to make arrangements with the airline to have someone stay with your child until we arrive. Solo Travelers (over the age by airline for unaccompanied minors):

If your camper is traveling alone, they will board the train from their gate and get off at baggage claim. There, a CAMP TELAPHIBA staff member will meet your child at the top of the escalators and GO WITH THEM to get their bag if they have check one. The staff member will have a CAMP TELAPHIBA sign and also be wearing a CAMP TELAPHIBA staff shirt, so they will be easily recognizable. Solo travelers are required to fly into DIA between 1pm and 3pm on Opening Day and fly out between 4pm and 7pm on Closing Day in order to use the **camp shuttle. If your camper arrives after this time frame, you will need to make arrangements with the Epic Mountain Shuttle for transportation to camp, and there would be no camp staff accompanying your camper.

Chaperones/Group Travelers:

If your camper is traveling with a group from your home studio, Camp Telaphiba will provide transportation to and from camp unless otherwise stated by you or your child's chaperone. Reach to your studio chaperone for flight and travel details.

Communication and Cell Phone Policy



Care Packages/Notes For Your Camper:

- Camper mail, such as letters, postcards or packages, can be dropped off with CAMP TELAPHIBA staff and can be given to your camper throughout the 5 days. Please designate your desire for delivery clearly on the packages.
- You may email your child during camp by sending your e-mail to yourfriends@camptelaphiba.com. Please put your child's full name in the subject line to ensure delivery to them. Due to the number of campers, please limit email to three submissions per camp. Emails will be delivered to campers once per day, typically each evening after dinner!

Camper Cell Phone/Camp Phone Policies:

At Camp Telaphiba, it's our job to help kids connect with dance, with nature and with each other. We want to build lasting skills, foster friendships and create lifelong memories. This IS doable even if they aren't saved on Instagram! As part of that initiative, we DO NOT ALLOW phones, laptops, tablets, ipads, ipods, apple watches and/or other electronics that have wifi capability at camp. We strongly believe this will enhance the Camp Telaphiba Experience and provide a stronger community and a needed break from the devices that we all rely on so heavily each day. Cell phone usage can interfere with and even sabotage a child's overall experience at camp. A camper that spends time immersed in technology or communications may do so at the expense of getting to know fellow campers and counselors. We all are looking forward to a fun-filled, safe, and happy summer without any of the worries of technology! We appreciate your cooperation.

Upon arrival at camp, campers will be asked to turn in their phones and devices at check in, or leave them with parents. All checked in phones will be kept by camp staff and turned off for the duration of camp. If a camper is caught with a phone or device at camp, the device will be confiscated and returned at the end of camp as well as parents contacted and ultimately could result in a camper being sent home from camp.

FAQs about this policy:

How will I get a hold of my camper or how will they get a hold of me?

The camp line will be available for use 24/7 by campers and parents. The phone number is 720-580-2267. We are very aware of the great responsibility in caring for your child. In case of emergency, either physical or otherwise, you will be notified immediately.

Where will they keep their electronics during the week?

We prefer and encourage your children to leave their electronics at home. Camp Telaphiba cannot and will not be responsible, for any reason, for the loss or damage to your children's electronic equipment including but not limited to cell phones, laptops, tablets, kindles, apple watches, cords and chargers etc.

What if my camper is traveling by plane/alone?

Campers under this circumstance may check in their phone with our staff to allow for direct communication while traveling both to and from camp. During camp, campers will check in their phone to Camp Telaphiba staff for safe keeping throughout the week.

Will extended campers get their phones in between sessions?

Extended campers are allowed to have their phones in between sessions. During the sessions they will check in their phone to Camp Telaphiba Staff for safe keeping.

How will my camper take pictures?

Campers can ask a Camp Staff or bring a digital camera/disposable camera.

How will my camper listen to music?

We suggest an inexpensive mp3 player.

How will my camper receive other camper's contact information to stay in touch with new friends? Campers will be given the opportunity at the end of camp to write down contact information of their friends!



Camper Health Guidelines



We are SO excited to host you for camp this summer and have prepared the following information to help you have a happy, healthy, and safe camp experience. We look forward to seeing you soon!! As we prepare for camp, we ask that you and your camper read through the following information!

- Camp Telaphiba follows the More Than Just Great Dancing![®] Safer Studio Guidelines which prioritize a hierarchy of safety and wellness measures including:
 - Wellness checks for staff
 - Frequent hand hygiene
 - Enhanced cleaning procedures
 - Facility and Curricular adjustments as needed
 - Gradual and continuous parent communications
- We have made a number of updates to our programs and requirements based on guidance from health authorities such as the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), the American Camp Association and State of Colorado guidelines for residential camps.
- Our commitment to our community means that we care deeply about the health and well being of our campers, chaperones and staff!

Please see below for the specific way Camp Telaphiba is applying these guidelines for 2024 Camps.

Camp Telaphiba recommends that campers and camp families follow certain precautions prior to arriving at camp, including the following steps:

- Limit your and your camper's exposure to COVID-19 or any other illnesses for 10 days prior to camp
- Practice frequent hand washing to prevent illness
- Monitor for any health symptoms

Camp Telaphiba REQUIRES the following precautions prior to arriving to camp:

- A COVID test pre-camp is no longer a requirement
- Fill out our Pre-Arrival form in your CampInTouch account 3-5 days prior to camp session start





DURING CAMP!

Wellness

- In addition to our outstanding rigorous safety and wellness training, all camp staff members will receive regular and continuing safety training as it relates to preventing community spread of any illness.
- Parents are asked to not send their children to camp if they have fever or respiratory symptoms or live in a household with someone exhibiting fever or respiratory symptoms.
- Parents are asked to not send their children to camp if they have had exposure risk to COVID-19 in the 10 days prior to camp.

Hygiene

- Campers and Staff will wash hands and/or sanitize regularly
- Please make sure all Camper items are clearly labeled this will help to avoid sharing and lost & found.

Visitation During Camps

• For 2024 camps, we are allowing parents and visitors on Thursday evening now for our NIGHT UNDER THE STARS! We are so excited to be able to have parents back for this event! The event will go approximately 7-9pm on Thursday and will be held at the Leggett Building. We will ask for an RSVP at check in so we can get chairs setup for the performance.

Communication

- Camp Telaphiba will send an email out each night with a summary of the day's events to keep families in the loop. This is typically sent late evenings after the campers have gone to bed!
- A camp staff will be available via phone during camp at 720-580-2267

Food

- Food will be prepared with all necessary health guidelines provided by our venue.
- Any food sent with your camper must be pre-packaged and labeled. We will be asking campers not to share food in their rooms with other campers.
- Reminder no nuts or seeds please as we have several campers with allergies.

- Dance Shoes specific shoes are NOT required. Campers can choose to wear dance shoes, go barefoot, wear socks or tennis shoes for each dance class. If you do not have shoes for each specific style of dance, you are NOT REQUIRED to purchase them.
- The Dance Crew "POP" please bring one accessory in each of the following colors: Turquoise, Hot Pink, Purple, White. The accessory is for you to accent your outfit for CREW performances at "Night Under the Stars". This could be a shirt, a jacket, a scarf, a hair flower, a glove, a tutu, a bracelet, socks, etc. GET CREATIVE!
- RETURNING CAMPERS Don't forget your anniversary pins! Campers will wear these throughout camp!

**All the clothing listed above is perfect for dance class. Campers do not typically change in between classes as they are quickly moving from class to class.

You do not need to bring A LOT. Camp wear is simple and comfortable.

**The rooms are equipped with sheets, pillows and towels.

What NOT to Bring

- Tobacco products, electronic games, expensive accessories (i.e. Sunglasses, watches, necklaces, etc.), excessive amounts of money, or food, or candy, and improper magazines or books. Alcohol, animals, weapons or drugs (marijuana, illegal drugs) are strictly prohibited.
- For the safety and concern of other campers, staff will confiscate any of the prohibited items.
- NO phones, devices or chargers
- Ultimately, if any of the other above items are brought to camp, they are the camper's responsibility and CAMP TELAPHIBA is not liable for any loss incurred.

Important Information Regarding Over the Counter Medications

- ALL MEDICINES must be turned in at check in to the Camp Nurse including over-the-counter medication. This is for the safety of the campers and a MANDATORY requirement of Camp Telaphiba.
 - This includes all prescription medications, ALL over the counter medications, vitamins, essential oils.
- The only approved medications that campers may have with them are inhalers and epi-pens and these must still be checked by the camp nurse upon arrival.
- The nurse is available 24/7 to provide campers with OTC medications as needed.
- Also if you are checking in medications and/or OTC items, they must be in original packaging any ziploc bags will not be allowed and will be disposed of if found at camp.



BALANCE DUE

To ensure your child's enrollment at camp, any balance due must be paid prior to your child attending camp. If you paid the deposit by credit card, your card will automatically be charged for the remainder due. Camp Telaphiba automatically bills in equal installments on the first of each month starting from point of registration. If registration occurs after January, we will charge equal installments each month leading up to June 1st. We will charge all final balances on June 1st. Your card will be charged on that date. You may pay your balance at any time prior to this date by paying through your camp in touch account.

CANCELLATION/WITHDRAWALS REFUND POLICY

- If a camper cancels for any reason, the camp deposit is non-refundable.
- If a camper cancels for any reason prior to May 1st, all monies paid over and above the initial non-refundable deposit will be refunded.
- If a camper cancels for any reason after May 1st, no monies will be refunded.

Cancellation Due to Camper Sickness:

If the camper is determined to be sick by CAMP TELAPHIBA on Opening Day of camp, the camper will need to be taken home to get healthy, obtain a doctor's note and return to camp later. If the camper cannot return healthy, the deposit will be transferred to the next summer.

If a camper becomes ill at camp and can't participate during all or part of the camp, due to fixed costs, no tuition refund can be made to the camper.

If a camper departs camp early for a reason other than a health concern (i.e. Sporting event, wedding, etc.), no portion of the tuition is refundable or pro-rated.

Camp Telaphiba reserves the right to dismiss any camper who becomes, in any way, detrimental to the best interest of the other participants at camp. We cannot give refunds for absences, dismissals or early withdrawal before the end of a camper's camp.



PHOTO AND VIDEO RELEASE

The participant understands that during Camp Telaphiba, the camp staff may take photos and video footage of campers during activities at camp. The participant hereby consents that photographs and/or videos involving participants may be used by Camp Telaphiba, it's assigns or successors, for Camp Telaphiba promotional purposes, including audio-visual productions, television, billboards, email campaigns, magazine or newspaper advertisements, newsletters, websites, social media, brochures and posters.
